Dear Chemist Friends,

All have been informed that, the Central Government has declared face masks and sanitizers as essential items and NPPA (National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority) has also issued circular that MRP should be prescribed on face masks and sanitizers. So do not sell and stock face masks and sanitizers without MRP.

Apart from this, the mask requires a Doctor prescription. To avoid any other complications, maintain a purchase record of the sale of face masks and sanitizers.

In this work, provide information about the black marketers at the district and state level. Buy goods with the bill and sell the goods by issuing bill, so that no action is taken against any retailers.

Sell face masks and sanitizers only with minimum margin in public interest, so that we all may be able to deal with this disaster as a partner of the government.

Your efforts will help in maintaining the image of your public health as chemist, but will also strengthen your image as Jan Swasthy Rakshak.

As you are aware the Novel CoronaVirus Disease (COVID-19) has now spread to more than 103 countries causing more than 106,800 cases and more than 3600 deaths worldwide. The World Health Organization (WHO) on 30th January, 2020 declared this outbreak as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) Though, WHO has not yet declared it to be a pandemic, it has advised countries to remain prepared for one.

2. Several confirmed cases have also been detected in India. Although, Government

community awareness about common signs and symptoms of this disease and

advocate simple public health measures, the community may undertake to prevent

infection.

Health and Family Welfare have designed posters & Audio Video products, some of

pharmacy shops and medicine retail outlets.

5. It would be highly appreciated if these materials are also displayed at any other

points of larger footfalls.

The 2019 novel coronavirus (2019-nCoV), Wuhan coronavirus, is a contagious virus that causes espiratory infection, can transfer from human to human.

Symptom

- Fever
- · Difficulty in Breathing
- Coughing
- · Tightness of Chest
- Running Nose
- Head Ache
- · Feeling of being Unwell
- Pneumonia
- Kidney Failure

Incubation Period: 14 days asymptomatic

Mode of transmission

Human Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) most commonly spread from an infected person to other through:

- · The air by coughing and sneezing
- · Close personal contact, such as touching or shaking hand
- Touching an object or surface with the virus on it, then touching your mouth, nose, or eyes before washing your hands

How to reduce risk of Coronavirus infection (2019-nCoV)

- Clean hand with soap and water or alcohol based hand rub
- Cover nose and mouth when coughing & sneezing with tissue or flexed elbow
- · Avoid close contact with anyone with cold or flu like symptoms
- Avoid frozen meet
- · Isolation of symptomatic patients for atleast 14 days.




